- Contribute positively and actively to our community, including helping out with farming, day to day tasks and any other work that is asked of you.
- Respect everyone's right to free speech, freedom of religion and equality.
- Be mindful of the environment do not unnecessarily use energy, do not litter, keep up cleanliness and hygiene in the village and follow the waste segregation rules.
- Maintain personal hygiene in order to protect yourself from illness.
- Do not behave in a way that would be considered offensive, violent or as harassment.
- Do not consume alcohol, take drugs or smoke.
- Abide by the Sristi Village constitution.

Sristi Village will:

- Provide a safe, nurturing environment in which each member is valued.
- Provide accommodation and food (three simple meals a day) at the village for all members.
- Provide training for at least three years based on farming skills and day to day activities.
- Facilitate members' independence by trying to help members find a suitable job outside the village or to enable members to stay permanently in the village in special cases.
- Invite parents or guardians to the village for periodical get togethers and keep them informed of members' progress.

Sristi Village is a welcoming, inclusive community that we consider to be a family. We are glad to welcome you into this community.

It is the responsibility and duty of each and every person of Sristi Village to become acquainted with our constitution and with this list of expectations.

If you are not able to act according to these expectations, Sristi reserves the right to ask you to leave the village.
