
But inclusion doesn't stop with care. It must lead to opportunity. To dignity. To belonging.


At Sristi, environmental protection is woven into our everyday choices. From sustainable farming to eco-friendly practices across our campus, we are committed to building a greener, healthier future.

TRANSFORMATION STORY

WHEN SILENCE TURNED TO "AMMA"

When **Kavin** first came to us at age two, he was silent born with profound deafness, clinging to his mother, unable to connect. His parents feared they had never heard his voice.

With steady support from our early intervention team, Kavin learned to lip-read, express through gestures and slowly, he began to engage.

Then came the moment we all waited for, he said "**Amma**."

Now four, Kavin communicates with confidence, explores with joy and reminds us that every child can grow with the right support.

"When I heard him say 'Amma' for the first time, I couldn't stop crying. It was the happiest moment of my life." — Kavin's Mother
