INTRODUCING FIRST SRISTI FELLOWSHIP: SHAPING LEADERS FOR INCLUSION



After 12 years in the disability sector, we saw a gap in skilled professionals. ***The Sristi Fellowship*** supported by ***Eaton India Foundation*** was initiated to train future leaders who create real change in rural communities. Our fellows live and work with families and children with disabilities, gaining hands-on experience to become visionary changemakers.

Recently, they put this into practice by hosting a workshop on ***"The Role of Students in the Disability Sector"*** at ***Kasthurba College for Women, Puducherry***. Students explored how inclusion is not just a concept but a shared responsibility.

MTP EXPOSURE VISIT: FIRST TRIP TO MAHABALIPURAM



Through our Mobile Therapy Project, we support ***100 children with disabilities across 88 villages. Many of whom are housebound*** and have never ventured outside.

This year, for the first time, these children traveled three hours to ***Mahabalipuram***, explored, shopped and socialized on their own.

It was a day full of roller-coaster emotions

and happy tears for parents and children alike. We are deeply grateful to our funders for supporting this life-changing project and for walking with us every step of the way.



GLOBAL EXPERTISE ON OUR FARM



Over the past months, Sristi welcomed three farm experts: **Lucky from Uganda**, **Neeraj from Bihar** and **Roland Frutig from Switzerland** who spent several weeks conducting **hands-on workshops** for our farm team. The sessions focused on **agroforestry techniques, sustainable farming and the latest trends in agriculture**, giving our team practical knowledge and exposure to global best practices.

These workshops have enhanced skills, strengthened our team's capacity and helped innovate our farm projects, contributing to the growth and development of our vocational agricultural programs.
